WHO can participate:

To participate in the camp, you must

- be between 18 and 23 of age
- be able to understand and speak English
- not be a resident of Denmark
- be sponsored by a Rotary Club in your own country
- have an open mind and an interest in the objectives of the camp

The camp is open both to male and female participants from all cultures and Beliefs. The camp is open both to relatives of Rotarians and to applicants without family ties to Rotarians.

ACCOMODATION: At Danhostel Givskud Zoo, located just opposite of Givskud Zoo close to Give.

INSURANCE: The guests are expected to bring their own insurance (health, risks and accidents inclusive of repatriation coverage)

VISA: In applicable cases, arrange for a visitors visa; you will receive a letter of invitation for visa purposes

COSTS: The guests pay for their own trip to/from Billund Airport (or Vejle Train Station), from where pick-up will be arranged. All other expenses are paid for by the Rotary Clubs, but we advise the guests to bring their own pocketmoney. Further a participation fee of DKK 500,- (70,- Euro) will be charged. This amount will be collected by the "Camp Leader" on the arrival day.
