“Sailing with “Jensine” in the Danish South Sea”

during the period of **Tuesday August 4th to Monday August 17th 2009**

The themes of the camp are: *See Southern Jutland (4 days) and go sailing with Jensine (1 week).*

Haderslev is a town in southern Denmark, located on the beautiful east coast of the peninsula Jutland. The first days you will stay at Rotarians home and see the Southern part of Denmark. The oldest Danish city Ribe, a trip to the “Danfoss Universe” and a day trip to the Capital Copenhagen will be part of the program. After a few days the young “summercampers” will go on board “Jensine of Haderslev”. This is the oldest wooden sailing ship in Denmark. The guests are the crew! A certified Captain and 1st Officer will be in charge on board.

Young people no younger than 17 and no older than 21 can join this camp. You are invited to send one girl or one boy.

ACCOMODATION: At Rotarian homes before and after the sailing trip as well as on board the ship “Jensine” (2nd week).

INSURANCE: The guests are expected to bring their own insurance (health, risks and accidents).

COSTS: The guests pay for their own trip to/from via Billund Airport (or Vojens Train Station in Southern Jutland), from where pick-up will be arranged. All other expenses are paid for by the Rotary Clubs, but we advise the guests to bring their own pocketmoney. Further a participation fee of DKK 500,- (70,- Euro) will be charged. This amount will be collected by the “Camp Leader” on the arrival day.

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Preliminary Programme

4th of August (Tuesday) Arrival of all “Sailors” to either **Billund Airport** or **Vojens Trainstation**. Pick up by Rotarians and stay at home of Rotarians in Vojens.

5th of August (Wednesday) Day-Tour to “Danfoss Universe”.

6th of August (Thursday) Excursion to Danish Capital of Copenhagen by Train. Meeting 06:45 at Vojens Train station.

7th of August (Friday): Sightseeing City of Ribe. Farmvisit. Danish Recycling Company “Dansk Affald”. Barbeque dinner at the house of a Rotarian.

8th of August (Saturday): Meeting at 13:00 at Port of Haderslev to board “Jensine” and sailing in Danish waters near Funen and Jutland for one week until:

14th of August (Friday): BBQ at the Island of Årø, barbeque with the sailors at the summer house of Camp Leader, Lene & Kim Fuglsang.

15th of August (Saturday): Return with “Jensine” to Haderslev and at 12:00 hrs “pick up” by the host families from Haderslev Rotary Club at the port.

16th of August (Sunday): Visit town of Haderslev and “Farewell Party” with Rotarians of Vojens and Haderslev Rotary Club. Meeting Point: 10:00 at Schaumanns Fabrikker, “Vognmuseet”, Simmerstedvej.

18:00 hours “Farewell Party” at the Fuglsang Brewery, Ribe Landevej, Haderslev where all Rotarians from Vojens and Haderslev are welcome as well as the host families. The Captain of Jensine (or a crew member) will tell about the trip. Perhaps the “sailors” will show a few pictures. Goodbye at about 21:00 hours.

17th of August (Monday): Departure back home by flight (from Billund) or train.

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Above programme is indicative and changes may occur. The arrival and departure days, however will not be changed.
