The first part of the 2 week camp will take place in and around Rebild in beautiful North Jutland, Denmark, and the second part on the Faroe Islands with their unique culture and spectacular scenery located in the middle of the Atlantic Ocean northwest of Scotland.

Torshavn and surrounding area on the Faroe Island.

Arrival to the camp in Denmark from your home country

Skoerping Train Station via train from Copenhagen Airport or directly by train during Saturday August 1, where your host family will pick you up. If your travel arrangements prevent you from arriving on August 1, please contact us, and we will make every effort to accommodate you.

Traveling to the Faroe Islands

Included in the camp program and arranged by the camp project manager.

Departure to your home country

Friday August 14 from Copenhagen Airport after 1 pm at the earliest. You should plan your return to your home country from Copenhagen Airport, alternatively Copenhagen Train Station.

Note! Weather conditions on the Faroe Islands can sometimes cause a delay in departure from Vagar Airport. We therefore recommend that you take out cancellation insurance for possible reissue of your ticket from Copenhagen to your home destination.
