discussions, sports (bicycle tour, high rope). The cities of Cologne, Essen, Münster and Düsseldorf will be visited and in The Netherlands the city of

Winterswijk.

Lodging: "Jugendburg Gemen" (a moated castle for youthwork) in Borken-Gemen

Costs: The travel expenses to and from Borken-Gemen must be covered by the

participants. They should bring adequate pocket money with them.
