Clothing

Light wind jacket (waterproof) Long and short trekking pants

Bathing costume

Underwear for mountain conditions (about 2000 mt height)

Waterproof hut or hood, light mountain mantle

Sunglasses

Sleeping bag is useless: we will provide a light bed bag
